Stewardship *"For the gifts and the call of God are irrevocable."* ROMANS 11:29 God has a special mission in mind for each of us. He has given us the gifts we need to accomplish that mission. We are called to be good stewards by using those gifts to do the work that He has planned for each of us. If we deny our gifts or fail to use them as God calls us to use them, then some part of His work will be left undone.

On the weekend of September 2/3 we will be hosting Fr. Simonraj Savarimuthu of the Archdiocese of Madras-Mylapore India as part of the Diocesan Mission *Cooperative Appeal.* A special 2nd collection that weekend will be taken up for this mission diocese. Madras Archdiocese, established in 1952 has its cathedral basilica built upon the mortal relics of Church's first Missionary. St. Thomas, one of the apostles of Jesus. In this area where 96% of the population is non-Christian (Hindu & Muslim), the Archdiocese is engaged in indirect evangelization through various mission works. 1530 women religious, 124 lay catechists, 163 diocesan priests along with 268 religious priests are involved in sowing the seeds of faith and revealing Christ's presence through several socio, religious, educational and family apostolates. Currently, we have a population of 12 million people out of which 420 thousand are Catholics. With the Mission Cooperation Appeal monies, the Archdiocese will try to build 12 small Mission chapels in the most backward region of the Archdiocese, Thiruvalluar district/county, for families to meet every weekend and worship God.

Reminder: If you sometimes attend Our Lady of Peace in Ashtabula, St. Joseph in Jefferson or St. Andrews in Sheffield, you can still use your regular Sunday envelope for Corpus Christi Parish. Just drop your envelope in the basket and it will be forwarded to us. In turn, we forward envelopes from parishioners of the other Parishes who occasionally attend Mass here.
