Christmas Eve/Day: Sun, Dec 24 ~ Mon, Dec 25, 2017: The Fourth Sunday of Advent will be observed on Sat evening, Dec 23, and Sun morning, Dec 24, 2017. Christmas is to be observed Sun evening, Dec 24 and Mon, Dec 25, 2017. There is an obligation to participate at Mass for both the Fourth Sunday of Advent and for Christmas that weekend. Attendance at one Mass does not fulfill both obligations.
