

#### **Guidelines for Fasting and Abstinence**

*Fridays during Lent* are obligatory days of abstinence. The norms on fasting are obligatory from age 18 until age 59. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal. The norms concerning abstinence from meat are binding upon members of the Catholic Church from age 14 onwards. *Good Friday* will be an obligatory day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics.
