Bishop Murry, S.J. will celebrate the **Sacrament of Confirmation for adults** on Sun, Nov 18 at 2pm in St. Columba Cathedral. This is a special opportunity for parishioners age 18 or older who have not received the sacrament to join with other adults of the diocese. Confirmation candidates must register with our parish and participate in the preparation. Candidates must be prepared and eligible to receive the sacrament by verifying baptism and marital status. Sponsors must be Confirmed, practicing Catholics (may not be the candidate’s parent). Contact the Parish Office by Oct 15 to register and verify eligibility.
