Stewardship *“So out of the ground the Lord God formed every beast of the field and every bird of the air, and brought them to the man to see what he would call them; and whatever the man called every living creature, that was its name.”* GENESIS 2:19 The creation story reminds us of two important points. First, since the start, God has put the entire world into our care. Second, stewardship has been around since the beginning of mankind, it isn't something recently invented by the Church. Just as past generations built our Church, it is now our responsibility to continue to nurture and develop these gifts for future generations.

Beginning this weekend we will be participating in **First Step for Change** a project sponsored by Catholic Charities to collect spare change (or dollars) to assist *local* low-income pregnant women and families with food, formula, clothing, diapers and other items essential to a child's health and well-being. Please pick up a baby bottle after Mass at the front or back of the church. Take it home and fill it with spare change throughout the month. You are asked to return your filled bottle at the end of the month. Thank you!

Bishop Murry, S.J. will celebrate the **Sacrament of Confirmation for adults** on Sun, Nov 18 at 2pm in St. Columba Cathedral. This is a special opportunity for parishioners age 18 or older who have not received the sacrament to join with other adults of the diocese. Confirmation candidates must register with our parish and participate in the preparation. Candidates must be prepared and eligible to receive the sacrament by verifying baptism and marital status. Sponsors must be Confirmed, practicing Catholics (may not be the candidate's parent). Contact the Parish Office by Oct 15 to register and verify eligibility.

Week 7 **The Spirit and the Eucharist** (Tues 1pm and Thurs 6:30pm - Parish Center) The Eucharistic liturgy is filled with the presence of the Holy Spirit. Sadly, many people don't experience the Holy Spirit, and attending Mass becomes a chore for them rather than a life-giving encounter with Jesus. In this segment of the **Wild Goose is Loose**, we look at the many ways the Holy Spirit is present in the Mass that will enable those present to encounter God when attending Mass.
